WiFi and Internet Access



Password: COST1004


Meeting Room Locations

ETSIT plan (FLOOR 0 and FLOOR 1)

- **Main entrance** is at FLOOR 1 level. **Registration desk** at FLOOR 0 is marked in pink. From main entrance at FLOOR 1, follow the red arrows and go to FLOOR 0 by the wide staircase.
- Assembly Hall (*Salón de Actos*) is located just behind the registration desk. It is marked in light pink. **Plenary sessions** will be held here.
- **Session rooms 1.0.6, 1.0.8** and **1.0.9** are located at FLOOR 0 level. They are marked in yellow.
- **Coffee breaks lounge and restaurant**, marked in green, is situated at FLOOR 0.




ETSIT plan (FLOOR 4)

- Follow red arrows at **FLOOR 1** level. Then get the elevator to **FLOOR 4**.

Gala Dinner (Thursday 7th February)

The Gala Dinner will be held at La Moraga restaurant (<http://lamoraga.com/es/antonio-martin>) in Plaza Malagueta, 4, 29016, Málaga from 8:15pm. At La Moraga you will enjoy Dani García's classic tapas and a really tasty menu. Its location with respect to the recommended hotels is shown in the figure below. The price for the dinner is included in the registration fee.

About the chef Dani García: from his Restaurant Calima (two Michelin Stars), in Marbella, this young but high-profile Andalusian chef combines traditional dishes with avant-garde techniques. Dani García's style of cooking is akin to that of a scientist, but only superficially, because he is and remains a cook who uses the scientist's knowledge for his taste experiments. He is comfortable with molecular cuisine; nowhere else can he live out his unusual ideas in the same way. With his unique recipes, the Spaniard is well on the way to following the "traditions" of his compatriots such as Ferran Adriá and Joan Roca, and setting new benchmarks in the kitchen.

El Pimpi restaurant (Wednesday 6th February)


This House has always been an emblem of the city, and a meeting place for young and not so young guests. With its typical Malaga decor, this charming winery allows us to enjoy the wines and delicious cuisine popular with local people.

From the Palomar and the terrace overlooking the Alcazaba and the Roman Theatre, you simply relax at a table among a large collection of old posters and signed boots from many celebrities (family Picasso, the painter Barcelo,

el Cordobes, the Duchess of Alba, Antonio Banderas, etc) that give good evidence of the history of this place.

El Pimpi (<http://www.bodegabarelpimpi.com>) is the venue of cultural events (poets, writers, painters, flamenco, film shoots, etc) A must-see spot for anyone who comes to Malaga.

Delegates who attend the dinner in El Pimpi should be there at 8:15pm. Museum of Wine Málaga (February 8th February)


The Museum of Wine Málaga (www.museovinomalaga.com), located just in the middle of the historic town, offers a journey through the History and the culture of the wine of the distinctive province of Malaga. The objective of this museum is to introduce and promote the wines defined by the Appellations of Origin "Malaga" and "Sierras de Malaga" and the raisins with the Denomination of Origin "Pasas de Malaga".

Delegates who attend the visit to the museum should be there at 5:30pm. A

wine tasting including detailed commentary will be provided to the visitors (courtesy of the museum). In addition, during the remaining days of the meeting (5th-8th), delegates who are interested can visit the museum (by showing the badge) having free access with no wine wasting (if desired, each wine tasting can be bought by 1€).
