University campus is connected by direct bus and tram to CAC and City Centre, as well as to the majority of the City area, in trips of 20-30 minutes.

## Getting in and around:

### PLANE

- › Valencia Airport is located in the nearby town of Manises, about 8 km away from the city.
- › Best way to reach the hotels in the City Center and the CAC from the airport is either taking a taxi, the airport bus, or the underground.
  - By taxi: the journey takes about 25 minutes and have a **fix fare** of 20 euros
  - Underground: Line 3 and 5 go to the Centre (stops Xàtiva or Colón). You need to buy a cardboard (1 €) and load a single ticket (3.90 €) to the city center. For more information visit [www.metrovalencia.es](http://www.metrovalencia.es) or download the [MAP](#)

### TRAIN

- › Valencia is connected via high speed train (AVE) with Madrid (95 minutes trip)
  - Madrid main station is not directly connected to the airport. From Barajas airport to Atocha station in Madrid you need to take a taxi with flat rate 30 €, or Bus shuttle, which are trips of 40-50 minutes depending on the traffic.
- › Best way to reach the hotels and the Polytechnic University Campus from the train station (Joaquin Sorolla) is either taking a taxi or the underground
  - By taxi: the journey takes about 15 minutes and costs around 10 €
  - Underground: a shuttle bus takes passengers to Xativa stop (Metro Line 3 and 5)

### METRO and BUS

- › Valencia has a good network of underground and bus lines. On buses, tickets can be get on board (in cash), and if you plan to make several trips it is convenient to get a travelcard, “bonobus” or “bonometro”. You can purchase these cards in most of the kiosks, libraries, and tobacco shops. ## Climate:

May is the best season to visit Valencia. You can expect excellent temperatures this week, on average max 26°C- min 15°C, very low probability of rain (5%).

## How to reach the iTEAM (Universidad Politécnica)

**From CAC area** (Hotels Primus, Barceló, Tryp Oceànic, Valencia Center, Confortel Aqua):

- By Bus (20'), Line number 1. Take it right in front of Aqua Shopping Mall, towards North. Stop at Lluís Peixò - Comte Melito (Stop ID: 1749). Single ticket 1, 50 €
- By taxi (5'); Ask to get to “Universidad Politecnica esquina Serreria” ( 4 - 6 € )

**From City Centre:**

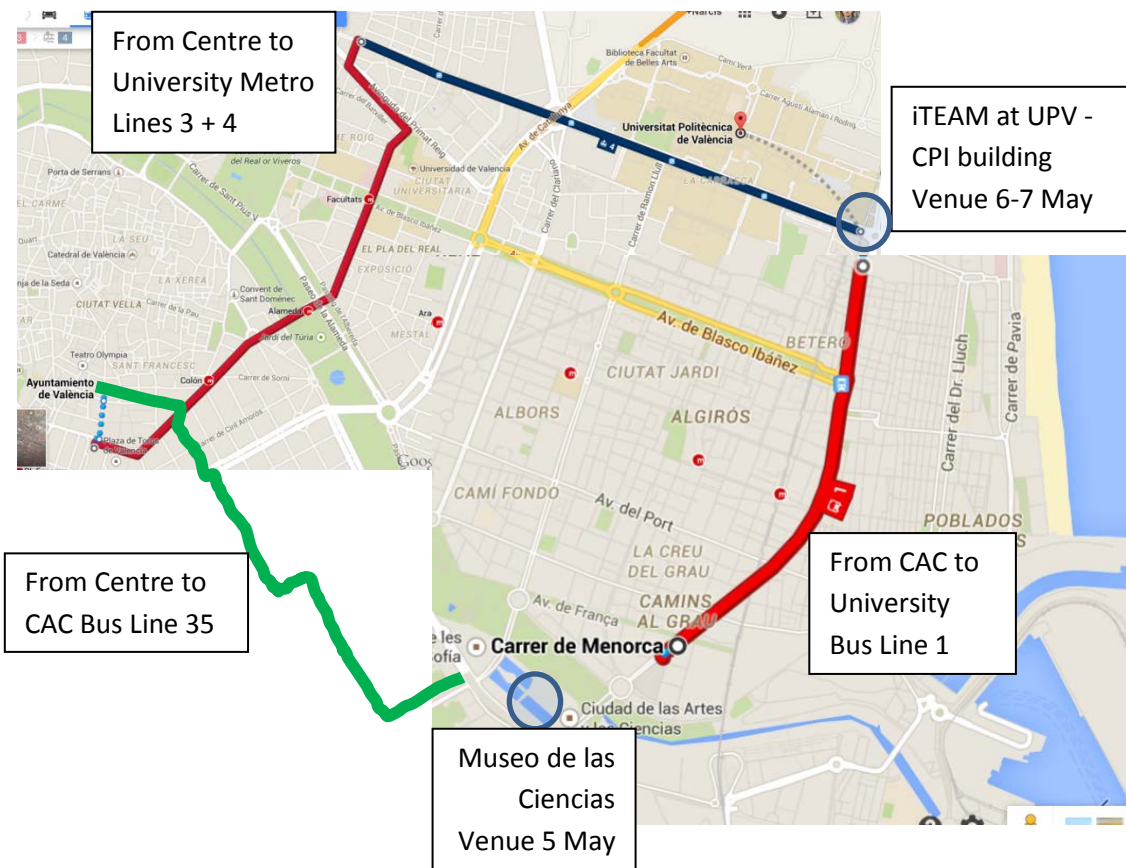
- By bus. (40')
  - Take number 71 at Plaza del Ayuntamiento /Barques (ID: 837) until Ramon LLull/ Tarongers (ID: 1283), then walk along the Avda. Tarongers to the East end of the Campus.
  - Take number 41 at Gran Via Germanias / Sevilla (ID: 708), stop at Tarongers/Fausto Elio (ID:1918), which is nearby the venue (CPI building).

- By Metro (30'): Take underground Line 3 at the Central Train Station (Xàtiva) or Colón, towards "Alboraia". Stop at Benimaclet and change to line 4 (Tram). Stop at Serreria, which is nearby the venue (CPI building).
- By taxi (15'); Ask to get to "Universidad Politecnica esquina Serreria" ( 6 - 8 € )

### How to reach the Ciudad de las Artes y las Ciencias (CAC)

#### From City Centre:

- By bus. (40')
  - Take number 35 near Plaza del Ayuntamiento (Marques de Sotelo/pasatge Rex) and stop in front of the Opera House (Palau de les Arts)
- By taxi (10'); Ask to get to "Museo de la Ciencia" ( 5 - 7 € )

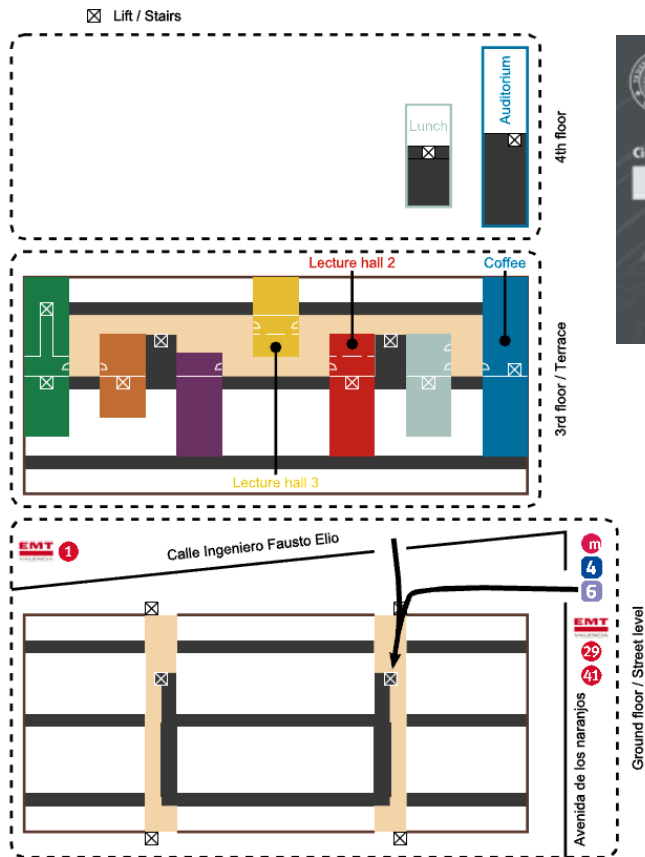


### Registration:

Participants are requested to register to the meeting through the Member's Area of the IC1004 website. ## Inside the Campus:

The UPV campus is a large area of about 200HA (2 km<sup>2</sup>). The Research Institutes are located at the East end side of the campus, in the Buildings of the “Ciudad Politecnica de la Innovación (CPI)”. See the maps in here: <https://www.upv.es/plano/plano-2d-en.html>



The meeting on the 6-7 May takes place in the CPI buildings, in the Auditorium rooms of the “cubes” Blue, Red and Yellow. There are also some small rooms available in case other parallel or working group meeting is organised. Lunch and coffees are also served in the same building, at the terrace level (3<sup>rd</sup> floor).

## WiFi:

UPV is part of the EDUROAM network, so colleagues from other European Universities that are part of this network will have direct access to the WiFi network. In any case, WiFi access will be available for all participants during the meeting. You will get a user and password at the registration desk.

The UPV takes cyber security very seriously and all networks are based either on WPA2-Enterprise or on VPN tunnels. Technically speaking, it is much easier to set up a VPN tunnel in your PC, so I'd recommend you to connect to the UPV-INFO network. 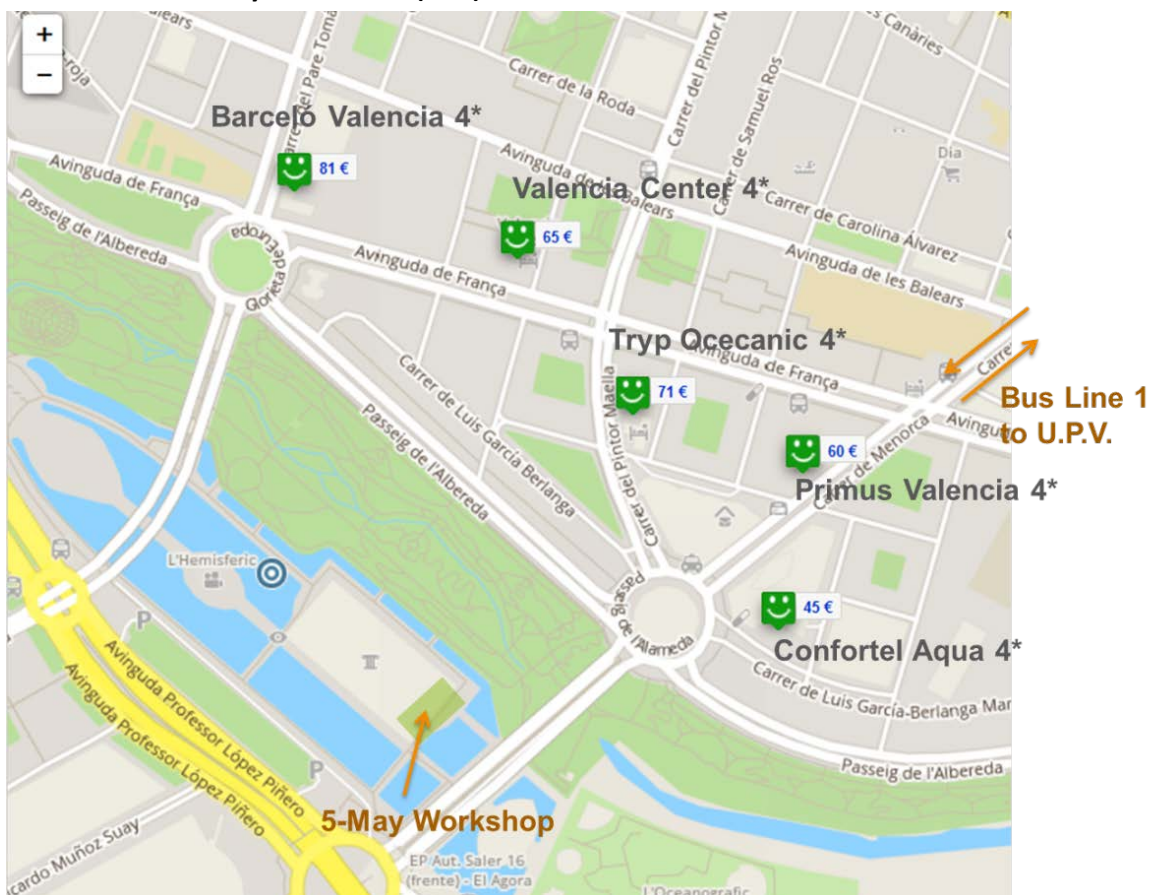
