Venue

The COST meeting sessions and the iPLAN workshop will be held at the Institut National des Sciences Appliquées (INSA) de Lyon, located within the LyonTech campus (aka La Doua). The campus map is provided in the next page for reference.

The LyonTech campus is located in northern Lyon. It is conveniently close to the main city green area ("Parc de la Tête d'Or") and well connected to the city center, train stations (Part Dieu and Perrache) and the St. Exupéry airport through public transportations (metro, tram and Rhône Express train). The registration desk will be at the "La Rotonde" building, "Agora" room.

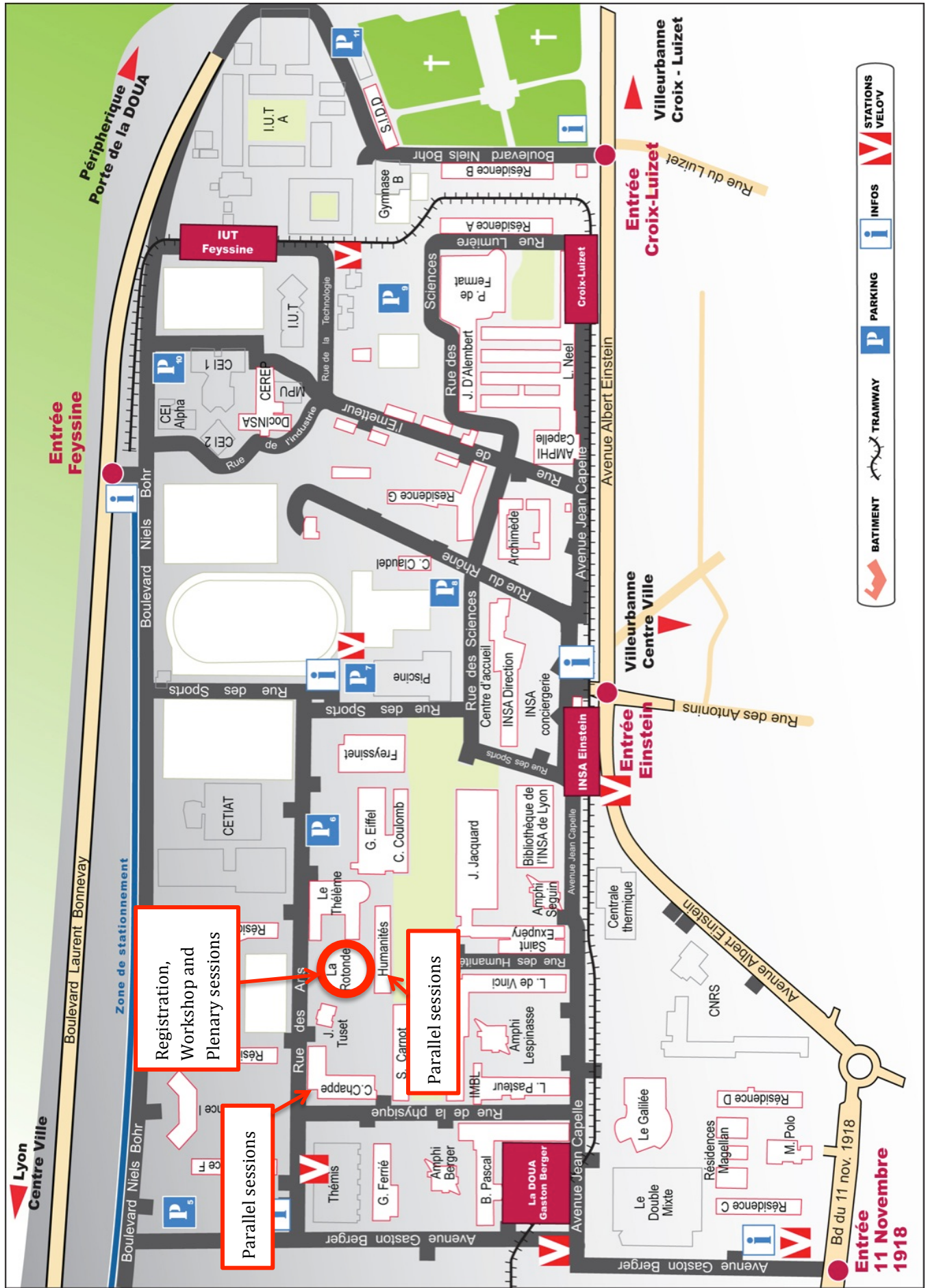
Technical sessions will be hosted at the following locations:
