

6th Management Committee Meeting: 5th – 8th September 2012, Málaga

The meeting venue is Escuela Técnica Superior de Ingeniería de Telecomunicación building (ETSIT), Campus de Teatinos, 29071 Málaga. ETSIT is located in Campus de Teatinos of Universidad de Málaga, 6 km westwards from Málaga downtown.

Getting from city downtown to ETSIT

There are two bus lines (L-20 and L-25) that allow you to get to the ETSIT from downtown. The bus driver will sell you the tickets (around 1 euro each ride). Bus L-20 has a departure frequency of about 10 minutes, and the ride takes 20 minutes. The head of this line is in *Alameda Principal*, just in the very downtown. You must get off at the last stop, so there is no chance to mistake.

Bus L-25 is less frequent and therefore less convenient, only recommended for those coming from *Hotel Maestranza* surroundings. The head of this line is in *General Torrijos* square.

Alternatively, taxi ride from downtown will cost you around 10 euros.

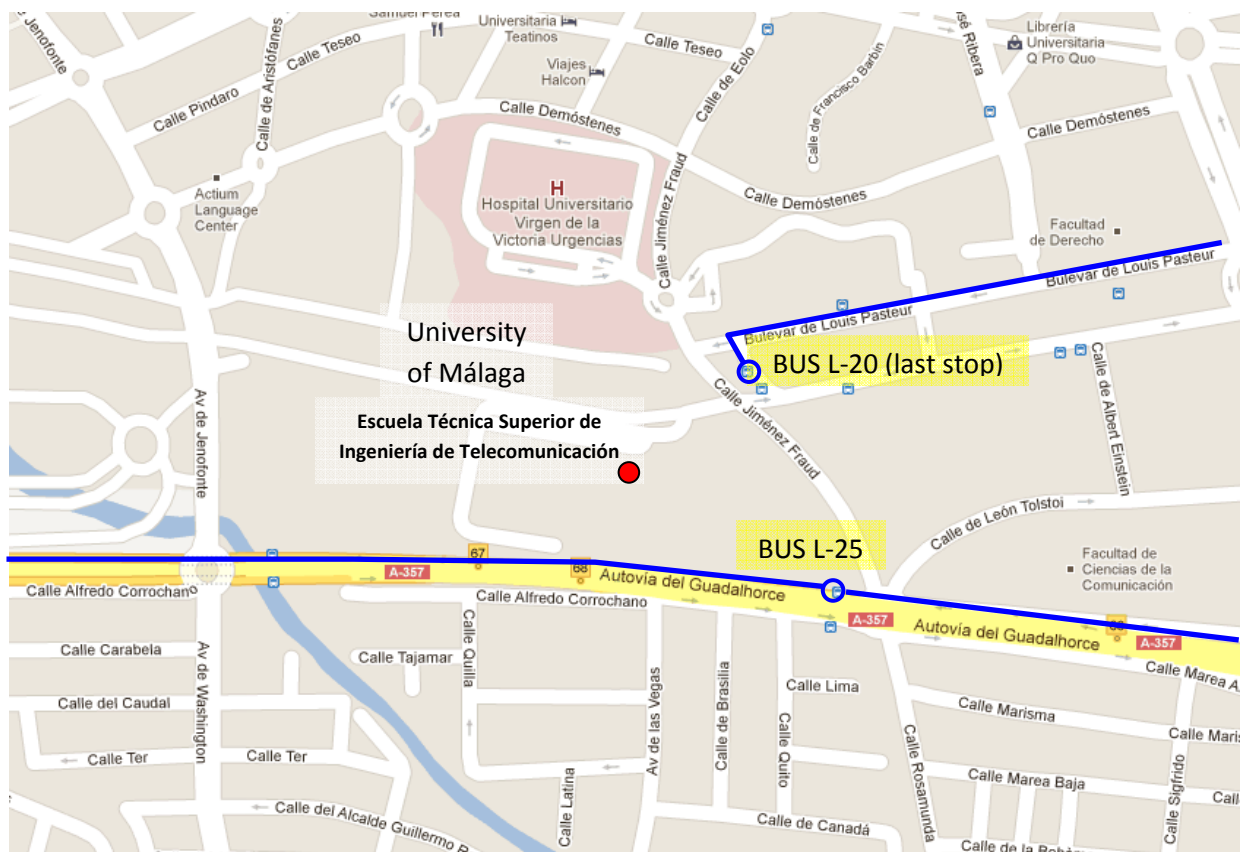


Figure 2. Map of University area, showing bus stops and ETSIT location

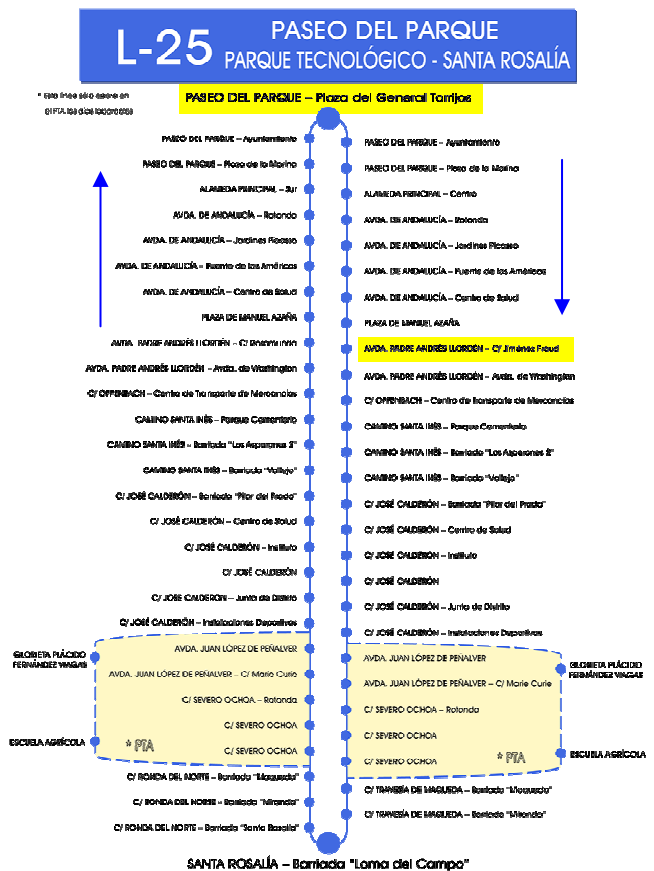
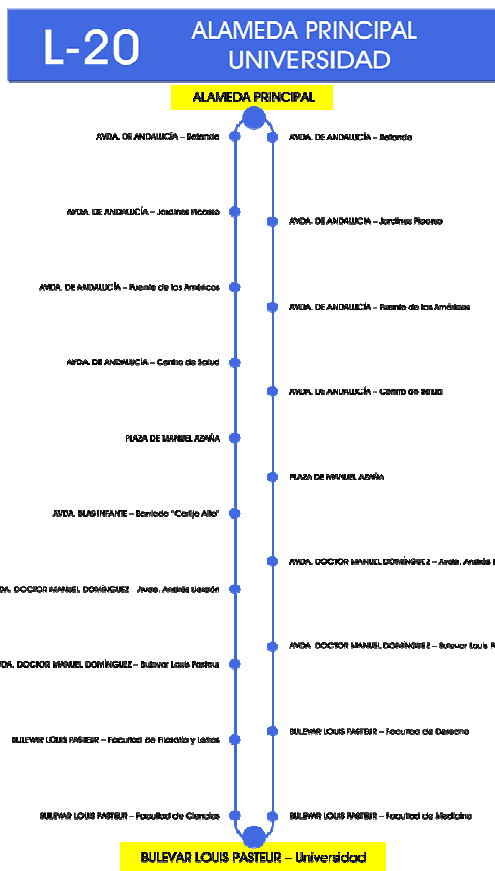


Figure 3. Bus lines L-20 and L-25 routes. Bus lines and timetables at <http://www.emtmalaga.es/portal/lineas-y-horarios>

Getting to Malaga downtown

By plane

Málaga is located in the heart of Costa del Sol touristic area and the airport is very well connected with main European cities. Málaga airport (code: AGP) is located 9 km from downtown. The suburban railway line C-1 connects the airport with “Málaga Centro-Alameda” railway station. This station is situated 500 m from downtown hotels zone (see Figure 1). The ride takes 12 minutes and the departure frequency is 20 minutes. You can check (in English) the departure timetable at <http://www.renfe.com/EN/viajeros/cercanias/malaga/index.html> (select “Aeropuerto” and “Málaga Centro Alameda”). Ticket price is 1,65 euros.

A taxi will get you from the airport to downtown in 10-20 minutes depending on traffic condition. The price depends on luggage amount or whether or not you arrive at late night, but it will be around 20 euros.

By train

Málaga is connected with Madrid, Barcelona and other main cities in Spain by the AVE high speed train system. It will take some two hours to reach Malaga *María Zambrano* railway station from Madrid. Málaga *María Zambrano* railway station is located 1 km from city downtown (see Figura 4).
